



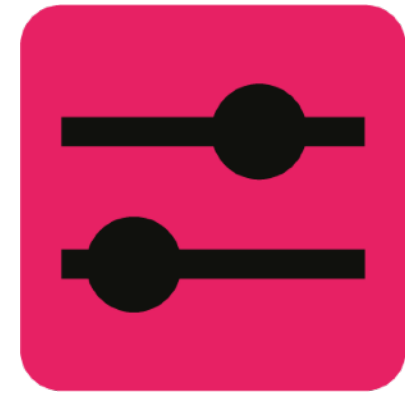

Simulator

What is it, who uses it, and how is it relevant to your climate response?

- A digital tool that facilitates deliberative prioritisation
- Helps to educate and inform respondents through the process of participation
- Captures meaningful and insightful responses that help to shape future decisions
- Supports organisations to make decisions with greater confidence

So what have people been saying?

Common themes discussed when speaking to UK authorities

1. Knee jerk reaction to national government declarations
2. Covid curtailed councils community engagement efforts
3. Lack of existing knowledge and difficulty in raising awareness
4. Climate change scepticism — ‘Are we facing a CE?’

How can Simulator help to overcome some of these challenges?

- Provides an open, easily accessible opportunity to get involved
- Simplifies complex issues so that everyone can have a say
- Opportunity for ongoing engagement, even during a pandemic
- Educates participants and encourages future interest
