

Embedding Rich Media into Citizen Space online consultation software

- Citizen Space has the functionality to let you embed interactive maps into consultations and allows users to make more engaged responses. Sometimes it is useful to embed media from third-party sites into Consultation records. Many sites provide 'embed codes' which are snippets of code that make it easy to include their content. For example, you can embed videos from YouTube, maps or interactive street views from Google Maps or PDF documents.
- Instead of using a static image of a map, Interactive maps can be a great way of displaying useful information in an engaging and attractive way by inviting the user to take action.
- When clicking on individual area of the map you can get details of the sites, search for a specific street, zoom in and out and see street level details.

See example screenshot of an interactive map we will be including as part of the Local Plan Consultation. This was originally created in our GIS web mapping system. Similar interactive maps can be created for other consultations.
