
- Has CS been through accreditation process elsewhere within UK government in recent years?
- Description of current technical Architecture.
- Statement on compliance with GDPR from Citizen Space service provider.
- Current certification to ISO27001:2013 and scope of same.
- Any other certification including other standards currently held?
- When was last ITHC completed and confirmation of completeness of remediation.

It is recommend that the countermeasures required to mitigate the risk level are applied in line with the following timescales (from the 1st day of the test) based on the vulnerability risk level and to be agreed with all third party Suppliers where applicable.

- Critical Risk Level <u>Immediately</u> and due consideration given to taking the system off-line until mitigated
- High Risk Level should be implemented within <u>1-2 days</u> not negotiable
- Medium Risk Level should be implemented within <u>7-10 days</u> 2 weeks could be agreed as acceptable
- Low Risk Level should be implemented within <u>6-8 weeks</u> this is already pushing the limits of a credible secure system!




