- delivers training and learning opportunities, giving advice and offering best practice guidance








## WHY WE USE CITIZEN SPACE

- Formal consultations
- Signpost to consultations on other platforms
- Surveys and feedback gathering









### MANAGING CITIZEN SPACE

#### SHARING THE RESPONSIBILITY:

- Admins role to review and approve
- Department users those who are supporting multiple surveys or consultations in their Directorate
- General / ad-hoc users use Citizen Space on a caseby-case basis, may be analysts or may manage surveys





- Alerts provide notifications of new surveys better oversight and planning for communications
- Opportunity to ensure questions and supporting text use simple, easy to understand language, in accessible formats
- Checks that we are meeting our legal responsibilities under GDPR and the Public Sector Bodies (Websites and Mobile Applications) (No.2) Accessibility Regulations 2018
- A communications plan for after the consultation closes







### **TIPS AND ADVICE**

- Ensure the survey leads are the ones using Citizen Space –
  ownership
- Have a conversation with the survey lead early to help them consider the options available
- Brighten up the questions with imagery
- Make use of the automation
